

Student Expectations

(Please read the following expectations, print off 2 copies. One copy should be turned into Ann McShane and the other copy should be kept with you during clinicals)

The following are standard care and performance expectations that each student will be held accountable for:

Uniform and Badge

- You will wear the appropriate uniform for clinicals and lab time.
- Your uniform will be professional in appearance (clean and free from wrinkles)
- Your shoes will be neat and free from debris.
- You will wear your school identification.
- You will keep all back packs and personal items contained or with you at all times.
- There will be NO CELLPHONES permitted.

Environment

- We want your learning opportunities to be conducive for best learning, therefore please **do not participate in bickering, back biting and gossip.**
- You are to treat ALL members of the clinical site with a professional tone and behavior.
- At NO time will students be allowed to manipulate, discriminate, or defame another.
- You are expected to notify your instructor of ANY and ALL concerns so they can be addressed in a timely manner.
- You are expected to care for and assist with the care of all patients. (meaning that you ensure patient's are safe, call lights are answered, provide explanation for all cares that you provide to the patient/family, and report all cares given to the nurse(s) you are working with).

Policies

- If you are performing a skill in which you have not performed in a skills lab or had "checked off" you must have your instructor with you to perform the skill.
- If you are performing a skill in which you have only had limited access to hands on experiences, you must ensure that you can do the skill, who needs/can observe you, and know the hospital policy on who can perform the skill (ie: students can NOT remove arterial lines—they can hold pressure post line removal).
- Refer to Galichia Heart Hospitals Intranet when you are here for hospital policies and procedures.

Unit Atmosphere

- You are to be proactive with your learning experiences, let your instructors and the nurses/staff you come in contact with know what experiences you need or would like to participate in based on your semester in school and within the scope of a nursing student.
- Remember to use professional respect for one another to include all staff you come in contact with.
- Trust is something that has to be established by the clinical sites and by you do your very best to represent your school and the nursing profession.
- You will ensure that you provide a hand off report to each care provider that you are working with in the clinical setting.
- You will be active in your learning experience (receiving report-documenting, seeking experiences and seeking resources)
